General Ideas

- Host a Career Day highlighting careers that involve the Arts.
- Read the new California Arts Standards for Public Schools: Preschool to Grade Twelve.
- Take a field trip to art museum, dance show, or theatre production.
- Have students create a personal symbol representing their artist strength and wear it as a name tag for the week/month.
- Host a family art, music, dance, theatre and/or multimedia night.
- Create a centralized space to share "Your Art, Your Story". Students can use Post-It Notes
 or pre-cut shapes to add to a large poster in the school library, lobby, or another communal
 area.
- Present a Talent Show.
- Do an art-related Manneguin Challenge
- Thank Your Art/Music/Drama/Dance/Media Arts Teacher Day with thoughtful notes and recognition.
- Recognize your arts providers for their work with students.




Visual Arts

- Chalk drawing on blacktop
- Host an art exchange/pen pal event
- Create and donate art to service people or senior facilities
- Draw or color a scene from a story & hang in public places
- Paint campus garbage cans, create a mural, or beautify your campus
- Student run craft workshops at lunch at school or a senior living facility
- How about an edible art project or a quilt project
- student can design coloring books, place mats or table tents to a them
- Art dress up days wearable art, primary colors, secondary colors, patterns, prints, or dress as your favorite artist
- face paint at lunch
- hang student art work at place of business
- Creating art game: one person is blindfolded and draws a specific picture. Their partner tries
 to guess what the person is drawing. The team that has drawn and guessed correctly the
 most objects is the winner

Music

- Karaoke and/or music at lunch
- Play Name that tune Guess the song title within the first 2-5 seconds
- Play musical chairs
- Dress-up days: Wear your favorite bands t-shirt, dress like a musician, etc.
- · Have student musicians play at lunch
- Host a "Battle of the Bands" or a "Rap Battle"
- Create a musical instruments in you Maker Space or Tinker Lab
- Have student groups or individuals play at staff meeting, board meeting, PTA, etc.
- Play music during morning announcements
- Sing the Star Spangled Banner after the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Host a body percussion drum circle
- Compose a song on Garage Band







Dance

- Rehearse and perform a flash mob at lunch
- Host a line dance at lunch or do the Chicken Dance
- Have a school dance party
- Use movement in class to teach a concept
- Do Zumba, Bollywood Dancing, or Jazzercise during P.E. class
- · Have a "Dance-Off" at lunch
- Have student dancers perform at lunch
- Teach a basic dance step to students

Theatre

- Have students perform scenes from plays at lunch
- Play Charades
- Have students create a monologue or dialogue on the importance of the Arts and share with school board
- Play lunch game of using stage directions stage left, center stage, etc.
- Create sets for school play
- Perform a school/grade level play
- Host a Reader's Theater
- Create a Theater Improv Hour like "Who's Line Is It Anyway?"





Media Arts

- Create school screen saver, logo, or t-shirt design
- Post pictures/video of activities to school web site and/or social media accounts
- Participate in the Student Voices Campaign by making a video on student vision of their school: www.studentvoicescampaign.org
- Collaborate with the art, music, theater, and/or dance classes and produce a video/slideshow promoting electives offered at your school
- Thank your Media Arts Teachers Day
- Host a student film festival in the multi-purpose room
